A poet and short story writer who decided to explore his identity as a submissive in the form of Shakespeare's immortal sonnets. Just as Shakespeare's sonnets were sensual love letters to no doubt forbidden loves, these sonnets are dedicated to his love of kink, female domination, spanking, sexuality and taboo.

Thank you for being in the Erotica Spotlight! Please tell us, what you write about and what your inspiration is.

I've written various forms of erotica, but my twitter is almost exclusively sonnets in the Shakespearean style. They're mostly kink based, largely Femdom, however I also draw inspiration from followers and people I follow on twitter. I play a little game and ask them for a subject or theme and then three or four words (related or unrelated) to weave into. I call them the "muse" of the specific sonnet. So while Shakespeare is an inspiration, I'd say its largely just a form, and the inspiration is my own erotic imagination as well as other imaginations.

Femdom, kink, and spanking are divisive concepts for some folks. What sort of feedback have you received, if any, on those topics?

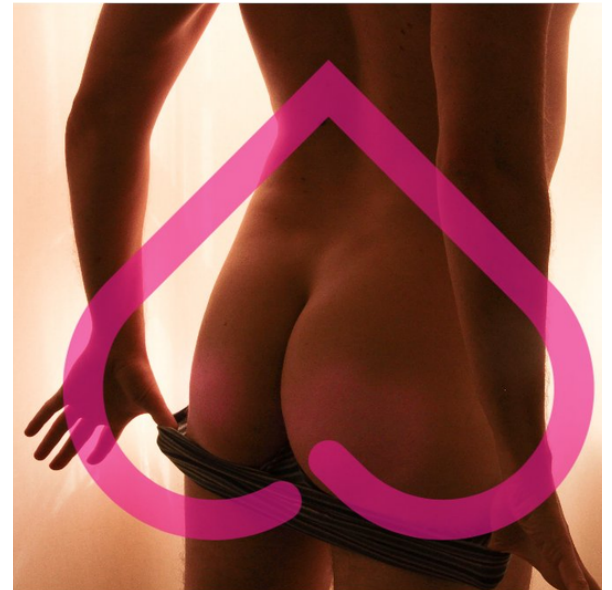
None, really. My twitter is now private so everyone who follows presumably is fine with it or likes it. People I follow are mostly just lovely.

Imagine you have the opportunity to read just one of your poems on the stage of The Globe Theatre in London, made famous by Shakespeare himself. Which one do you choose?

Haha, probably the first one I ever wrote. "That thing that in the light I did despise/Was in the dark what made most unwind." are the first few lines.

You have published a book of your sonnets, congratulations! For those of us that love your work, are there more books to come?

I wrote a full Shakespearean style kink Femdom play called: "To Court & To Keep" and while I think its pretty finished, I've been too lazy/too unqualified to properly format it. As much as people like to pretend they'd be interested, I don't think it's something that would be in high demand, so I haven't been too motivated to put it out there. But thank you! My 154 sonnets are available and there are hundreds more since that I post sporadically on my twitter, and more to come!
